

**Description:**

1986 Pacific Seacraft Dana 24

*Rag Doll* is a good example of a Pacific Seacraft Dana 24, the well-known and respected ocean-going cruiser designed by W.I.B. Crealock. The boat is described in many on-line articles and written publications including John Vigor's *Twenty Small Sailboats to Take You Anywhere*.

*Rag Doll* has been well maintained and has many upgrades mainly geared towards cruising. She has spent several winters in both the Bahamas (crossing from Florida) and the Sea of Cortez (crossing from San Carlos). The boat comes with a trailer which allows it to be moved easily between sailing locations and often reduces storage costs (to zero on private land). The trailer is included in the price and the owner wishes to sell both together. The new and upgraded engine and associated equipment (Yanmar 3YM20, in 2013) make the boat particularly attractive compared to others of its age.
