

THE CRIDDLER AREA

Near the end of the cliff the trail climbs up towards the dry-tooling cave and there are three sport routes that start on a higher ledge to the right of some large trees. The climbs are accessed by scrambling up behind the trees and up to a scree ledge above a large slab of rock. The climbs have probably not been repeated and the grades are unconfirmed. However, they look well-cleaned and ready to go!
